Bouncy Castle Risk Assessment

Prior to the use of a 'Bouncy Castle' within our setting the following risk assessment will need to be completed.

<u>Risk:</u>	<u>What has been done to reduce the risk:</u>	<u>Confirmed by:</u>
Has the equipment received a full inspection by the supplier:	Check paperwork to see if there is anything in writing to ensure equipment receives this or that the supplier has shown a valid inspection certificate.	
Suitability of site:	Has a suitable location/position been established that is free from anything that may affect its operation? And has this been agreed with the supplier?	
Anchorage of the bouncy castle.	Is the bouncy castle anchored sufficiently to ensure that it remains in the chosen location?	
Damage to Fabric & Seams.	Has a visual inspection been made to ensure that the equipment is fit for purpose?	
Blower Location.	Has the blower been set in a place that is unlikely to be reached by young people? And are all connections robust?	
Matting:	Has an area of soft matting been established where the users of the play equipment can walk over to and from the equipment?	
Weather conditions.	Will adverse weather conditions affect the use of the equipment?	
Supervision arrangements.	Has the supervising staff been made aware of any agreed limitations on use e.g. the max. number on the

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	equipment at any one time? Any children who are not allowed to use the equipment?	
Footwear.	Have arrangements been made to remove and store the footwear of those using the equipment?	
Access.	Has an area been agreed as a boundary around the equipment?
